***Additional Subscription Policies***

- Pass holders are encouraged to make advance reservations for all productions, to ensure seat availability.
- Most productions are open seating. Season Subscribers may request Priority Reserved Seating by contacting the Box Office at least 24 hours prior to the performance. You must pick up your tickets at the Box Office at least 10 minutes prior to curtain or your reserved seats may be released to other patrons.
- Open Pass holders may reserve repeat attendance dates at their 4 Main Stage and 6 Collage/Presented performances starting 3 days prior to the performance date. You must pick up your tickets at the Box Office at least 10 minutes prior to curtain or your tickets may be released to the general public.
- Packages may not apply to special performance events that may be added from time to time.
- Passes are nontransferable; however, Pass holders may gift their tickets for a particular performance to a third party (Note: Open Pass holders who give away their tickets for a performance may not take advantage of the unlimited visit option for that production).
- Village Productions/Tri-PAC reserves the right to cancel, reschedule, or substitute offerings at its sole discretion. In the event that a subscriber event is cancelled and not rescheduled or substituted with another production, you may receive a pro-rata refund of your subscription price, or you may apply your refund to a ticket for a future Village Productions event, at your option.
- If you are unable to attend your scheduled performance or event, please be sure to change your ticket reservation at least 24 hours in advance. There are no refunds for missed performances.
- If you are unable to attend a performance, you may donate your tickets by contacting a Box Office representative at least 2 hours before the performance. We will issue a written acknowledgement of your donation equal to your subscription ticket price.
